Training Goal

- 1. Walks towards Plant pot
- 2. Moves beak towards dirt
- 3. Uses beak to touch dirt
- 4. Digs hole with beak
- 5. Once this step is at 100% move to customer section

Notes

Use target signal to your advantage (single finger pointing to location) Criteria for bridge and reward opening beak and touching finger gently.

A possible easy way of teaching this behaviour may be bury an almond in the dirt. (Needs to appear that he's digging a hole)

I am not fused if he doesn't get the nut in the hole just in the plant pot is fine
